Qualification of candidates includes a Ph.D degree, at least the assistant professor certificate issued by the Ministry of Education of Taiwan and 1 years of research and teach experience.

Successful candidate for this tenure-track position is expected to teach a variety of courses in the following fields (in Chinese and English) :

Graduate courses: Sociology of Work, Social Security and Work-related Sustainability.
Practical course in Sociology of Work is preferred.

Undergraduate general education courses: Sociology of Work, Social Security and Work-related Sustainability.

6. Four syllabi of courses (including one in English and three in Chinese) you intend to teach.
